OVERVIEW

Our ideal career is a balance of skill, income and passion. This lesson provides students with a framework for evaluating their dream job and demonstrates how the same core set of skills can translate into many different career paths.

GOALS

- Provide students with a framework for evaluating their career choices
- Help students identify and articulate their own interests and skills
- Demonstrate how the same set of skills can translate to many different career choices

OBJECTIVES

- Identify the three components of a fulfilling career: income, skills and passion
- Evaluate common dream jobs based on the three components of a fulfilling career
- Make inferences based on text evidence to connect skills with career choices
- Define income as the money you earn when an employer hires you to work at a job

ASSESSMENT

An optional quiz has been provided with this lesson plan (the quiz is not factored into the lesson's 45-minute runtime).

Did you know? Kids' dream jobs have changed little over the years; top career picks include doctor, veterinarian, police officer and teacher.

(Making Money)

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Ask your class the following questions:
 - What is a job that you would like to have someday?
 - How can you tell if a job is a good match for you?

Highlight any mention of income, interest, skills, passion or purpose that comes up during the discussion.

- 2. Introduce the topic: "When choosing a job or a career, there are three important things to think about. Let's watch a short video together and see if we can spot those three things."
- 3. Show VIDEO JR1
- 4. Go over PRESENTATION JR1
 - Pause at the "Ask Yourself" slides and invite the class to share their responses
- 5. Distribute **ACTIVITY**
 - Divide students into small groups
 - Distribute a character sheet to each group and allow time for students to answer the questions within their groups

- Invite each group to present their findings to the class (Optional: display the relevant character sheet as each group presents, so the entire class can follow along)
- Use the answer key to supplement each group's answers and to discuss their interpretations
- 6. Wrap up by sharing the following:
 - The same set of skills and interests can be used to fill many different jobs
 - We may have one or many dream jobs in the course of our working life
 - Choosing our career is a mix of income, skill and passion
- 7. (Optional) Distribute **QUIZ** for individual assessment.
- 8. (Optional) Distribute copies of **COMIC JR1** and **ACTIVITY SHEET JR1** for students to take home.






